- Knowledge of community services and a clear understanding of best practice in the early childhood intervention area,
- Experience within the Disability Sector and current NDIS environment is advantageous,
- An ability to think strategically and problem solve,

- An understanding of risk management frameworks to minimise risk exposure
- A high level of communication and interpersonal skills to negotiate and influence the team and develop partnerships,
- Understanding of service delivery and key performance indicators (KPI's)
