As a Senior ECEI Coordinator you will be a key point of contact for families whilst working within a transdisciplinary team. You will work closely with families to support them to identify their child's service needs and to set goals that will assist the child in everyday environments. You will support families to access community-based and mainstream supports. You will also gather information to identify the appropriate referral pathway for the child and support the family to access these services which may include the NDIS. You will provide short term interventions where appropriate and develop and monitor goals with the family.

You will also provide leadership, mentorship and supervision to ECEI Coordinators and will have demonstrated expertise and experience working with families who have complex needs.

To be eligible to apply for this role you will be tertiary qualified in Early Childhood Education or in an Allied Health discipline. You will have considerable experience in delivering services/support to children with developmental delay or disability. A current Police Check, Working with Children Check, Victorian drivers licence, Clinical or professional registration and Level II First Aid (inclusive of CPR) certification are essential.
