

Team Leader – Children's Services

This is a permanent part time (or full time negotiable) position with a supplementing clinical case load, based at our Oakleigh site.

- Lead quality improvements
- Support program planning in line with funding and service agreements
- Inform and assist in developing new opportunities to expand the programs
- Represent and advocate for the team within the organisation and collaborate with external stakeholders
- Provide clinical service delivery and clinical supervision within their scope of practice
- Assume the duties of the Child Safe Officer, provide guidance for the team to uphold the child safe standards and support the team to facilitate reports as appropriate.

- Demonstrated understanding of the needs of complex families and systems that support them
- Hold a recognised tertiary qualification in either; Allied Health, Counselling or Nursing

- Possess a style of leadership that complements Link HC values
